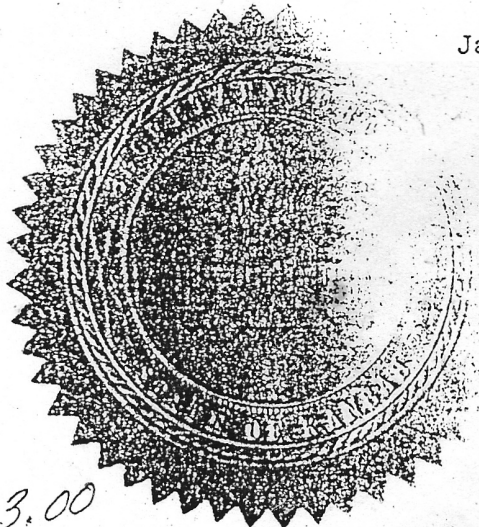

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

FRIENDS OF THE SISTER CITIES, INC.

WE, the undersigned incorporators, hereby form and establish a corporation NOT FOR PROFIT under the laws of the State of Kansas, and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE 1

The name of the corporation is:

FRIENDS OF THE SISTER CITIES, INC.

ARTICLE 2

The location of the corporation's registered office in this state is 500 N. Market, Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas, 67214. The Resident Agent at this address is W. Stanley Churchill.

ARTICLE 3

This corporation is organized NOT FOR PROFIT and the nature of the purposes to be conducted or promoted by the corporation is to establish and maintain an association of persons interested in encouraging goodwill and cooperation between Wichita, Kansas and its sister cities and to secure funds and materials for the benefit of the City of Wichita, Kansas, Sister Cities Advisory Board, and to these ends, to receive and hold gifts, property and funds for such purposes and to promote programs and engage in fund raising activities on behalf of the City of Wichita Sister Cities Advisory Board. To further such purposes, the corporation shall have and exercise all the powers conferred on corporations by the laws of the State of Kansas.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that in all events and under all circumstances, and notwithstanding merger, consolidation, reorganization, termination, dissolution, or winding up of this corporation, the following provisions shall apply:

Purpose clause

(a) This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

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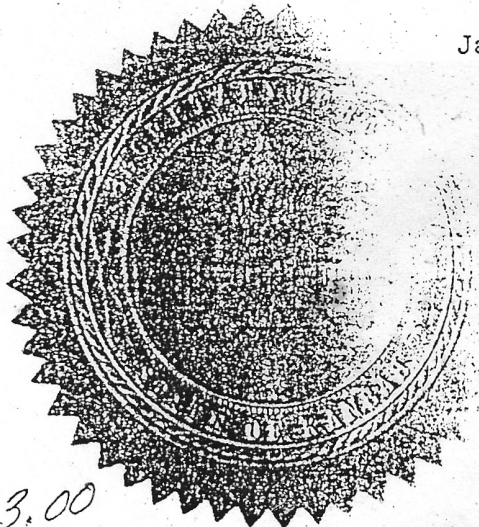

(b) This corporation shall not have or exercise any power or authority either expressly, by interpretation, or by operation of law, nor shall it directly or indirectly engage in any activity that would prevent this corporation from qualifying (and continuing to qualify) as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law). This corporation shall not engage in any activity not permitted to be carried on by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

(c) This corporation shall never be operating for the primary purpose of carrying on a trade or business for profit.

(d) No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles of Incorporation.

(e) No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Dissolution

ARTICLE 4

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors or governing body of the corporation, after paying or providing for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, shall dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively: (1) In accordance with the purposes of the corporation, in the manner determined by the Board of Directors or governing body, or (2) to organizations qualified for exemption under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (26 U.S.C. §501(c)(3)), and specified by the Board of Directors or governing body. Any assets of the corporation not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the district court of the county where the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for the purposes of the organizations provided above, as determined by the court.

ARTICLE 5

The corporation will NOT have authority to issue capital stock and the conditions of membership shall be set forth in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE 6

The Board of Directors of this corporation shall have all powers granted to Directors by applicable Kansas Law. The number of Directors of this corporation shall be as provided in the By-Laws, and may increase or decrease from time to time by amendment of the By-Laws.

ARTICLE 7

The term for which this corporation is to exist is perpetual.


